****IMPORTANT PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS****

AIR TRAVEL: Effective January 8, 2007, passports will be required for all U.S. Citizens traveling to or from all international air travel destinations including the Bahamas, Bermuda, Canada, the Caribbean, Mexico, Central and South America. ALL PERSONS traveling by air outside of the United States are required to present a passport or other valid travel document to enter or re-enter the United States.

LAND AND SEA TRAVEL

The following summarizes information available on the Department of Homeland Security's website. On June 1, 2009, the U.S. government will implement the full requirements of the land and sea phase of WHTI. The proposed rules require most U.S. citizens entering the United States at sea or land ports of entry to have a passport, passport card, or WHTI-compliant document. It is our recommendation that all US Citizens traveling outside the US carry a valid passport.
 For the most current passport and visa information, please visit the US Department of State website at www.travel.state.gov.

A valid passport is required of all non-U.S. and non-Canadian citizens for all itineraries. It is also required of all U.S. and Canadian citizens sailing on non-domestic itineraries including Africa, Asia, Australia and New Zealand, Europe, India, Central and South America, South Pacific and Tahiti. Many countries require your passport to be valid for six months from the completion of your travel. Check your passport to ensure it will be valid for this period of time. Please ensure the name on the passport matches the name on the booking. Additionally, ensure your passport contains blank pages for entry and exit endorsements and any visas that may be required. If necessary, allow sufficient time to renew your passport and/or obtain additional pages.

ON LINE PRE-REGISTRATION/IMMIGRATION

Due to new US Department of Homeland Security regulations for cruises departing from US ports, all cruise lines are now required to submit a final departure manifest at least 60 minutes prior to departure. As a result of this new regulation, guests are required to provide the cruise lines with registration information prior to embarkation.

Once you receive your cruise receipt with your booking number please go online to fill out your online Immigration information. Guests that do not complete the registration process prior to embarkation will be required to check-in at least 90 minutes prior to the published sailing time or they will be denied boarding (no refunds will be provided). If any changes are made to your booking after you are registered you must go back to your online registration and update your form.

PREGNANCY

Prior to 24 Weeks of pregnancy, a Dr's letter must be submitted to the cruise line authorizing travel, and must include notification of the date of expected delivery. Should the woman reach 24 Weeks of pregnancy just prior to or during the cruise, boarding will be DENIED and no refund will be issued. Please check with your travel agent to determine eligibility to travel if you are pregnant.

FUEL SUPPLEMENT
