COST: MEMBERS: \$66.00 (includes mandatory cart, green fees, and range balls, hot dog before shotgun start, dinner and Awards after play.)

GUESTS : \$86.00

ALL EOY GOLF FEES MUST BE PAID IN ADVANCE OF PLAY.

PLEASE CONTACT YOUR TEAM CAPTAIN, FOR YOUR PARTICIPATION.
YOUR TEAM CAPTAIN WILL COLLECT ALL FEES. PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR TEAM CAPTAIN WITH YOUR FOURSOME OR ASK HIM/HER TO PAIR YOU UP WITH A GROUP.

MONTGOMERY COUNTY CLUB WILL NEED THE FINAL PAIRINGS BY *OCTOBER 5, 2010*.
THEREFORE, YOUR TEAM CAPTAIN WILL NEED TO COLLECT THE FEES AND ESTABLISH PAIRINGS NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 5.

TEES TO USE:

BLUE: Back tees ... 6713 yards; 72.7/129
WHITE: Middle tees ... 6239 yards; 70.6/126
GOLD: Senior tees ... 6053 yards; 69.8/123
RED: Forward tees ... 5496 yards; 71.1/123

DIRECTIONS: Take I-270 North from the Beltway (I-495) to Exit 9, bear right to 9A onto I-370. Take I-370 to Shady Grove East ramp. Continue on Shady Grove and turn right onto Route 124, Woodfield Road. Turn right at the second traffic light onto Fieldcrest and continue until it dead ends at Route 108. Turn left onto Route 108 and drive approximately ¾ miles. Turn right onto Golf View Drive. The club is at the end of the road.

DINNER AND AWARDS, IMMEDIATELY AFTER GOLF:

NIHGA End-of-Year Outing Scramble Rules

FLIGHTS: Four/three player groups will be divided into several flights in order of group handicap.

1. For each foursome (or threesome), the team handicap will be determined by averaging the individual handicaps for the four (three) players.

2. The handicap for guests will be based on:

- (a) Their NIHGA handicap index, if they had been members during the previous season.
- (b) or their USGA handicap index, if they have one.
- (c) otherwise zero.

3. Guests all must use the middle (white) tees; rating 70.6, slope 126.

- (a) Multiply the guest's handicap index by: $(126/113) * 0.85 = 1.115$.
- (b) Round the result up or down to an integer value.
- (c) For example, an index of 9.5 yields the result 10.59, which rounds to 11.

COMPETITION:

1. A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.

2. The other team members pick up their balls and, in turn, place and hit their next shot from a spot within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot

3. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.

4. Putts need to be played from within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.

5. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you can not drop or place the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.

6. If a group has only 3 players then 1 person will hit twice, rotating on each hole, so that they will have 4 shots total for each new shot.

7. Each team must use at least one of each team members tee shots on each nine (minimum two tee shots per player per round).

8. All NIHGA members and former members with valid NIHGA handicaps will hit their drives from the same tees that they used during their latest season. Guests will use the middle tees for men and forward tees for women.
